****Take this form with you to the assessment!****

- You must have the Original part (for solos) or Original score (for ensembles) for the judge with correct edits, measures numbered, your name (OR "SANTALUCES HIGH SCHOOL" if it belongs to SHS) in the upper right hand corner. NO COPIES FOR THE JUDGE. Make sure to erase all of your markings on the judge's original part/score. Put the judge's original part/score in a folder or a large envelope to keep it clean and neat. On Monday, February 5th, return all originals that belong to SHS to Mr. Nikolovski.

- Performance attire—plan ahead. Coordinate ensemble attire. Dress for the occasion.
- Have PARENT DRIVER transportation to and from John I. Leonard High School. (Student drivers may only drive themselves – no student passengers). Arrive at least 1 hour prior to your 1st performance time.
- Notify your accompanist of your solo time, judge, and room number.
- You are responsible for bringing all music, instruments, equipment, sticks/mallets, extra reeds, oils, grease, straps, mouthpieces, etc....that you use. PLAN AHEAD.

· Locate your performance room 1st, then warm-up properly IN THE WARM-UP ROOM. There is no playing outside or in the hallways.

- *Get to your performance room at least 15 minutes before your listed performance time – the judge may have had cancellations and will want to hear their next event as soon as possible.*

- Remember proper performance etiquette: Introduce yourself and your piece to the judge. Maintain good eye contact. Be professional. After listening to the judge's comments, say "Thank You."

- The performer(s) decide whether an audience can remain in the room. If you do not want an audience, let the judge know you would like the room cleared. (Does not apply to auxiliary events)

- All woodwind and brass players who play school instruments: You MUST bring back all school instruments to Santaluces on Monday, Feb. 5th. PLAN AHEAD.

- COLORGUARD. Double Check all of your timing requirements and coordinate with your teammates accordingly. Remember all of your equipment.

- Mr. Nikolovski and Ms. McNeil will be present. There are multiple events occurring at the same time. Therefore, send us a remind message if you need us in an emergency.

- Remember to use proper performance etiquette.
- Be courteous and polite to your judge and to the hosting workers.
- Ratings usually take at least an hour to post after your performance. *Be patient* You do not have to wait for your ratings if you need to leave.
- Directors ONLY are allowed in the FBA Office.
- Students should not have any contact with judges outside of the performance room
- Your family & friends should not initiate any contact with judges at any time.
- Any concerns should be brought to Mr. Nikolovski and Ms. Oser only FBA President We will usually be in the FBA Office (come to the door and ask for me, don't walk in.
- View your ratings and those of others **with class and restraint**. You are representing your band and school – make us proud of you.
